Re: Electricity Distribution Licence Condition 31E - Distribution Flexibility Services Procurement Statement

Last Mile Electricity Limited (LMEL) is an Independent Distribution Network Operator (IDNO) that owns electricity distribution networks throughout the UK with approximately 240,000 connected customers.

Please find below the below reporting submission in relation to the electricity distribution licence condition 31E (LC31E).

1. Flexibility Services Requirements

All LMEL networks are designed for the capacity that is required and we have not identified any requirement for distribution flexibility services during the year 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024.

Therefore, we currently have no plans to procure any distribution flexibility services as there is sufficient capacity for current and projected future demand.

If any need arises in the next 12 months for LMEL to procure such distribution flexibility services, we shall comply with LC31E and publish the outcomes of a tender within a month of contractual agreement.


